



1. University Core Questions ($\alpha = 0.95$)





3.1) Please provide your opinion on the grading format in the class. Was it beneficial to your learning experience? Please type your response in the box provided.

- As a lower level course i would have preferred the points be mkre spread out isntead of having 3 assignments that can make or break oir grade
- Grading format was fine. What was good was the amount of constructive feedback given for each graded work. Not a lot of professors go into that much detail and it was appreciated.
- I am frustrated with grading because it is not truly clear how to get a certain grade and it was never truly outlined that I can recall. There is never a rubric or a checklist type of expectation.
- I think his grading format works well! For those who may struggle, he offers frequent extra credit that is easy to obtain. I find his grading scale and efforts to be very fair and just.
- It is more stressful to only have a few big assignments throughout the semester, since it puts a lot more pressure on the student to do well.
- My professor Dr. Bivens is very clear on how things are graded, and if you have questions he is happy (and quick) to answer them. You need to apply yourself to get the grade, and that's true across college level courses.
- The grading format across the entire campus is confusing, as you cannot see your current cumulative grade anywhere, but I believe Dr. Bivens does an amazing job of allowing our grades to truly reflect what we are getting out of the class.
- The point values seem a little low for essays and the exam, compared to my other classes. Having a rubric for essays would also be very helpful, in order to know why a certain amount of points was taken off.

One improvement I would suggest would be describing the expectations for projects a little more in depth and providing a clear rubric with point values. Overall, I think he is a great professor and very knowledgeable in the subject.

He could have implemented some of the readings into the lectures/discussions a little more. They felt quite separate from the lecture material.
