




1. University Core Questions ($\alpha = 0.1$)




2. PLS Department Core Questions ($\alpha = 0.42$)






1.1) Instructor demonstrates command of the subject/discipline.




1.2) Instructor effectively organizes material for teaching/learning.




1.3) Instructor is readily available outside of class. (The instructor is available during office hours and appointments for face-to-face sections or electronically for technology-delivered sections.)



1.4) Instructor presents knowledge or material effectively.




1.5) Instructor encourages and interests students in learning.









- Dr. Bivens is a kind man who seems genuinely interested in both what he teaches and fostering his students interest. I can't say that I have any particular complaints on how Dr. Bivens conducts himself as an instructor.
- Dr. Bivens is a very successful instructor, you can tell that he truly cares about all of his students and their success inside and outside of the classroom. He could improve by having a few more discussions, even if they were short (possibly at the beginning of class) because most of the class was lectures. This is also due to switching from a 3 day to a 2 day class, which altered the initial schedule he had, so it is just something to keep in mind for future sections of this class.
- I believe Dr. Bivens is one of the best professors I've had and even though we don't always have questions, it helps when he asks the class just in case. I was a big fan of our discussions and one thing I'd personally prefer would've been if we were all able to present together our findings, instead of just depending on one person at the end. I think it helps especially with such a small class number. I think it would help us not put so much pressure and have other people more keen on presenting, so it's just a suggestion! I still think taking notes during the discussion is effective and necessary. I think if we'd known beforehand some of the questions over our reading over the book discussion could create better conversation, but either way I think it was already great. Other than that, I believe the lectures are always full of interesting aspects that I enjoy.
- I loved taking this class with Bivens! I liked the discussions and projects we did. Sometimes I found myself wanting a couple small assignments throughout the semester to keep myself engaged and have some grades in. Other times, I felt like I had a fairly small amount of time for big projects like the country profile or research proposal.
